## Summary of the June 14, 2012 OWASA Board Meeting

*Please note: The summary below was prepared by OWASA staff and is not approved by the OWASA Board. The OWASA Board of Directors:

- **Approved the annual budget for July, 2012 through June, 2013; the capital improvement program for the next five years; and rates that will go into effect in October, 2012. There will be no increase in monthly water, sewer or reclaimed water rates in October.** However, various charges including system capacity or “service availability” fees for new connections will increase based on updated costs. OWASA has cost-of-service rates.
- **Elected Alan Rimer as Chair, John Young as Vice Chair and Amy Witsil as Secretary of the Board effective on July 1.**
- **Discussed a staff report on OWASA's procedure for identifying and notifying customers who have high water use in a given month, and related items regarding on-line bill information and informing customers about typical residential water use.**
- **Cancelled the June 28<sup>th</sup> Board meeting.**
